Poonam Mathur : Addl.Govt.Advocate for respondent. - - -</p> <p style="text-align: center;">This appeal seeks to get the order of learned Revenue Appellate Authority, Ajmer dated 29.5.2002 quashed.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">The learned advocate for appellant has stated that this is a temple land and nobody can get khatedari rights over this. He has further stated that in view of this, the appeal needs to be accepted and the order passed by learned R.A.A. needs to be set aside.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">The learned advocate for respondent, on the other hand, resisted this contention and has stated that the trial court and learned R.A.A. have considered all relevant issues and passed issuewise clear orders on the basis of facts of the case and therefore appeal needs to be dismissed.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">We have perused the case record and heard the learned advocates from both sides.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">After careful consideration of all the material, we find no reason to interfere with the orders of the learned Revenue Appellate Authority, Ajmer dated 29.5.2002.
