Bhatt : Dy.Govt.Advocate for the non-petitioner.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">- - -</p> <p>These two revision petitions have been filed against the order of learned Additional Colonisation Commissioner, Bikaner dated 24.8.2005 on the ground that the petitioners have not committed any fraud or have misrepresented any fact and if the name of father and details of family were not written, it does not amount to fraud and thus make the case liable for cancellation. They have further pleaded that they being illiterate people, cannot be punished in such an old allotment merely on technical grounds.</p> <p>Learned Dy.Govt.Advocate for the State has strongly objected to the contentions of the advocate for the petitioner and has stated that this revision need not be entertained as the learned Additional Colonisation Commissioner has dealt all the issues and has passed a just & proper order.</p> <p>I have heard the learned advocates on both sides and have seen the material available on record.</p> <p>After careful consideration of all the relevant material, I find no merit in the arguments made by the learned advocate for the petitioner and therefore, dismiss these revision petitions.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Pronounced.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">(Shikhar Agrawal) Member</p>
