22-7-2020	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Division Bench</u></b> <b>Shikhar Agrawal, Member</b> <b>Jameel Ahmed Qureshi, Member</b></p> <p><b><u>Present:</u></b> Shri Ashok Agrawal: counsel for the appellant. - - -</p> <p>This is second appeal filed under Section 224 of Rajasthan Tenancy Act, 1955 challenging the order of learned Revenue Appellate Authority, Bharatpur camp Deeg dated 21.02.2006 by which he has upheld the order of Sub Divisional Officer, Deeg passed on 30-04-2005.</p> <p>We have heard the learned advocate, who has argued that issue wise judgment has not been passed by the lower courts. He has further argued that the oral evidence regarding possession of the disputed land has not been duly appreciated by the lower courts and therefore orders passed by lower courts set aside.</p> <p>We have heard the arguments and perused the case record.</p> <p>Case record clearly shows that no substantial evidence has been produced in any of the lower courts. Further, the land is recorded as Pokhar on which rights cannot be transferred under Section 16 of Rajasthan Tenancy Act, 1955. Learned Revenue Appellate Authority, Bharatpur and as well as Trial court has duly considered to the submissions made by the appellant and have passed concurrent orders denying the rights sought.</p> <p>In view of the above, we find no reason to interfere the concurrent orders passed by the two lower courts.
